WW1 Commemoration Event, Ingleton Village Hall: Sunday 11th November @ 11.45am

Afterwards at 11.45am Ingleton Village community groups and volunteers have pleasure inviting all residents to the Village Hall for this commemoration at 11.45am following the St. Johns' Church Service. It will remember the young parishioners of Ingleton Village who went off to World War One and did not return by featuring, from the era, live music, poetry readings, a WW1 Memorabilia Table and a free Royal British Legion wrist band bracelets for the young. Homemade cakes, beverages, soft drinks will be served.

- **11.45am** Welcome with cakes and drinks followed by children and adults reading their own and soldier poets' poetry and facts about WW1.
- **12.15pm – 12.30pm** Villagers will read 'Who are these men' beside the poppy and flower decorated canvas.
- **12.45pm** A reading of the poem 'Coo-ee' written by the Welsh soldier poet Edward Thomas, followed by a poetry reading by all.

All residents and their families and friends are assured of a warm welcome. A BIG thank you to all parents who have confirmed their child's attendance at this event.
