The cost of a school meal is £2.05 (£10.25/week). For children who do not receive Free School Meals the cost for the first half of the Autumn Term will be £77.90 (seven weeks, three days). Children in Reception, Year One and Year Two will still receive meals free under the Universal Infant Free School Meals Scheme. A polite reminder that this should be paid weekly / in advance and NOT at the end of term. Payments must be made via Parent Pay
