### **UK Parliament Week**

As Parliament Week begins on **Saturday 2nd November**, we are taking on contemporary politics for this week's Votes for School topic. The question KS2 will be discussing is "Are young people interested in politics?" while we ask KS1 "Would you like to be a politician?"

The KS2 lesson asks pupils to critically assess the effect young people could and have had on politics, as well as giving them the opportunity to look at different political parties and form their own views. It is hoped this will prompt some heated debates and may help to re-engage those whose instinctive answer to the question is no.

In addition to this six children from Class 3 will be taking part in a cross school debate with five other local schools on Brexit this Friday at St Chad's RC Primary School in Witton Park. Helen Goodman MP will also be attending and leading the debate.

### **Anti-Bullying Week 2019: 11<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> October 2019 Change Starts With Us**

Anti-Bullying Week happens in schools across England each November. This year's Anti-Bullying Week has the theme Change Starts with Us and is happening from **Monday 11th November - Friday 15th November 2019**.

Odd Socks Day forms part of Anti-Bullying Week. It is a chance to celebrate that we are all unique. All we ask is that pupils wear odd socks on **Tuesday 12th November**. The day sends an important message to pupils that they should be allowed to be themselves free from bullying and helps us celebrate Anti-Bullying Week in a fun and positive way.
