

Class 2 Autumn Term 2 Challenges

Our challenges this term are all linked to our new History topic. **Each child is expected to complete at least one of each colour challenge this half term.** We would prefer it if your child could send us their work via email to my email address l.smith460@ingleton.durham.sch.uk. If your child would like to bring their work into school they may but they will need to be put aside for 72 hours before presenting it to the class. **It is also expected that children read at home AT LEAST 3x a week.**

Stone Age Stones

Collect stones to draw Stone Age pictures on. You could use paints, chalk, or charcoal.

Skara Brae Fact File

Why is Skara Brae important? What can you find out about it? Research Skara Brae and create a fact file with all the information you gather.

Stone Age Story

On paper, tell a story or leave a message through pictures. You could scrunch up the paper, so it looks like a cave wall!

Stone Age Clothes

Design an outfit thinking about the materials that would have been available at the time. Draw and label your design explaining why you have used certain materials. You could even try to make it!

Shelters

Stone Age houses were made from the materials that people found around them. You could collect twigs to make the structure and cover it with moss or fabric to create your own model home.

Recount

Write a day in the life of a Stone Age man/ woman. Would they have hunted or gathered?

Stone Age Recipe

People of the Stone Age couldn't go to the supermarket like us! Everything they ate had to be caught or gathered. Can you write your own Stone Age recipe? Think about the ingredients they would have used.

Stone Age Painting

Paint using only sticks, feathers, or your fingers just as Stone Age people would have.

Animals

Research the animals that lived in the Stone Age. You could draw pictures and add some facts.

Stonehenge

Why not make your own Stonehenge? Use boxes to create a model as big as available space and materials will allow.

I would like to try my own idea

You might have an idea of your own that you would like to try. Remember to record your work in some way. It could be through a piece of writing (leaflet, diary entry, play script, poem) or photographs, puppet show, game, diagram, artwork etc.
