

Class 2 Summer Term 1 Challenges

Our challenges this term are all linked to our new Geography topic, 'What happens where the land meets the sea?' Each child is expected to complete at least **one** challenge this half term.

We are having a huge push on times tables this term and we will be completing daily times table challenges. We recommend you practice your times tables at home as often as possible to ensure you make good progress.

Create a model of a coastline using a box- it could be a shoebox or bigger!



Take a trip to your local coastline. What coastal landforms will you see? Spot wildlife, find different beach types or go rock pooling! Document your trip and share the fun you had with the class.

Create an awareness campaign to encourage people to stay safe at the coast. It could be a leaflet, video or radio advert.



Investigate a coast: It could be in the UK or outside the UK. Include: Images, a map of the coast, interesting physical facts (rock type, beaches etc) and interesting human facts (pollution, tourism etc)
